## **Purpose**

To provide elected members with an update regarding Community Night Patrol.

# Background

CNP in West Daly has lost number of staff due to community fights and personal issues.

## Recruiting new staff.

CNP team leader across the region has been consulting with community members, seeking potentially would be suitable applicant to fill in our current vacancy within CNP. Interviews will be conducted in the near future.

We have 3 position in Wadeye, 2 in Palumpa and 1 in Peppimenarti.

## Community unrest Wadeye.

For the last month and a half the community of Wadeye, has been extremely divided with the ongoing clan groups fights. More than 100 man got locked up and families has been impacted severely.

CNP has relocated and transported lot of families to a safe area. The TRT unit has been dispatched into Wadeye which has made the community much safer for woman and children.

#### **CNP Vehicles.**

The Wadeye Hi ace has been inspected by TDC workshop and it's now registered. A lot of the CNP vehicles still need to have few accessories be install such as the spots light/UFH/Bull bars/ side lights and a lot of electrical works still needs to be done.

# **CNP** will be partnering with other stakeholders:

Our regional CNP team has recognise having a safer community means working with other stakeholders and developing programs that would help community members steer away from engaging into anti-social behaviours.

Wadeye CNP has been in discussion with TDC in developing a man safe house, we are still waiting for confirmation to use the green shed that was used for army cadets.

Palumpa CNP would like to seek approval by TO's to use and develop the old workshop shed. This shed would serve as a youth drop in centre to help curve anti - social issues in the community. They are also interested in helping man have a men shed for art and craft, this would give man an outlet to vent. We would like to ask if Councillors Mr Narburup and Mr Minjin to seek written approval by the TO's Jack.

Catholic Care NT will be teaming up with Peppie Night Patrol to assess and provide an ongoing support with individuals dealing with mental health and AOD issues. The first appointment will commence 28/01/20 Time 10:00am.
