GENERAL BUSINESS

Stuart McGill advised that Chief Minister Michael Gunner has stated that by 30 April 2020 he hopes enough progress has been made to contain COVID-19 in the NT that "we can begin planning our path back to normal."

The Chief Minister also stated:

- There is to be a slow and staged easing of some of the NT's restrictions but he can't yet state what or when.
- Businesses will open well prior to our borders being opened.
- · Social restrictions are expected at least six months.

Elected Members also requested an update as to when the Port Keats Road works are to commence and Stuart McGill advised that he is to enquire and report back to Council.

Councillor Minjin advised that there is a funeral in Wadeye on 24 April 2020.
