Elected Member Commitment Statement

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to provide Elected Members with the West Daly Regional Elected Member Commitment Statement **for signing** provided as Attachment A.

Background

A Commitment Statement is common practice in leading organisations and leadership teams and seeks to encompass the values and ethical behaviours of high performing leadership teams.

At the Ordinary Council Meeting held on 21 September 2022 Council approved the further development of the Commitment Statement and made a commitment to signing the statement.

Council has now developed the Commitment Statement which incorporates the key behaviours for Elected Members to uphold, being:

- 1. Uphold the values of West Daly Regional Council
- 2. Working together and not undermining each other
- 3. Holding each other accountable for our behaviours


